Cllr Mrs Goodworth asked why it had taken three attempts to find a good headteacher. Cllr Mrs Falconer asked what the Parish Council could now do. Cllr Betts said that the way forward for a new school was to attract enough for a new reception class, which would then move through the school, with new children coming into reception each year.
