280 It was proposed by Cllr Mrs Goodworth, seconded by Cllr Osborne and agreed the minutes of the meeting held on 6<sup>th</sup> November 2017 be signed as a true record.

## **MATTERS ARISING** 4

282 No matters were raised.

The Chairman suspended the meeting to allow Cllrs Rayner, Betts and Coffin to speak.

Cllr Rayner reported that there had been a decision to go out to consultation on rural bus services, as the County Council wished to eliminate the subsidy. It would be a gradual matter. So far there had been only one comment from the parish.

Cllr Betts said that a name was being sought for the new development at Plaxdale Green Farm. Some suggestions were made, but members were asked to consider the matter and bring forward ideas for the next meeting. He said that the Local Plan had been on track, but the Government had altered the criterion

for housing needs and there would now be a consultation on the formula and methodology. If this went ahead the number of houses would be raised from 696 to 859 a year, which was a figure that had never been delivered in the Borough. This would not apply to Local Plans being submitted by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018. The head of planning considered that because of legislation procedures, it was unlikely that the submission could be brought forward to make this deadline. The waste services contract would be out for retendering in 2019. More recyclables would be collected from the kerbside and the collection of garden waste would be an optin and would be charged. The recycling centre was back in service at Borough Green. Travellers had bought land next to the Holiday Inn at Wrotham Heath and had moved onto the land.

Cllr Coffin said that it was envisaged the budget would be increased by 2%.

The Chairman thanked Cllrs Rayner, Betts and Coffin and reconvened the meeting.

Stansted Parish Council has no objection in principle to this application, but considers the removal of render to Vigo House should not be approved without consideration of the adjoining Vigo Cottage. The external appearance of both properties should be the same, either render or brickwork. If the render is to be removed to expose the brickwork, an application should also be submitted for Vigo Cottage.

Members of the Parish Council who have lived in the parish all of their lives remember the external finish as always having been rendered. In addition, one member who is a retired builder is of the opinion that the render is concrete based and that the original bricks would be damaged if the render were removed.
